COVID 19 POST LOCKDOWN PLAYER GUIDE

The following procedures form our policy of

“Play Safe. Stay Safe”

during these times of Government imposed restrictions as a result of the COVID 19 pandemic. A copy of these is available on our web site and all players will receive a hand out prior to play over the next couple of weeks.

- * Travel to Rollo Park individually unless you are sharing a car with someone you share a house with and do not arrive more than 15 minutes before your tee time. There will be no practice facilities available.*
- * Practice social distancing when parking and exiting your car.*
- * Come changed ready to play and change your shoes in the car park. **The Pavilion will be closed – no access to the toilets will be permitted***
- * There will be a Starter on duty for a minimum of 8 hours every day – commencing 8.30am Sunday to Friday and 7.00am on Saturday. These hours will be constantly reviewed and be subject to demand.*
- * It is strictly forbidden to start before the first tee off time (9am Sunday to Friday, 7.30am Saturday). If you require use of the buggy, please phone the Starter. It will not be available for tee times after 3pm.*
- * Maintain social distancing (2 metres rule - 2 club lengths) on tee areas, greens and throughout your round*

- * 2 balls only. Social golf only (red and yellow tees) - this will be reviewed over the next few weeks**
- * Tee off every 15 minutes as per the on-line booking sheet. This will greatly help the merging of games at the 10th and avoid groups of golfers gathering at the 1st / 10th.**
- * Keep the flag in the hole. Golfers are asked to carefully remove their golf ball from the hole, not with a golf club.**
- * All bunker rakes have now been removed. Please "rake" the bunker with your club or feet after use. If you find a bad lie in a bunker then you may lift and place your ball in another area of the bunker without penalty (new LOCAL RULE).**
- * It is important that you play safely, but not slowly. Maintain a good pace. Keep up with the game in front rather than just ahead of the game behind. A maximum of 3 minutes is permitted when searching for a lost ball. A 2 ball social game should take no longer than 3 hours (MAXIMUM)**
- * Golfers should only pick up their own ball and wipe on their own towel which, ideally, should be clean. The ball cleaners have been taken out of play as has the airline cleaner and the ball scoops on 5 and 6.**
- * We have removed all litter bins. Please take your litter home with you. We are unable to sell refreshments, balls, tees etc so make sure you bring your own.**
- * Do not share any equipment, such as golf clubs or rangefinders.**
- * Don't shake hands before or after your game.**
- * We recommend that you bring your own sanitiser – keep it in your bag and definitely use after your game.**
- * Enjoy your game but don't hang around afterwards. Drive home safely**
